1 position for an Assistant Professor

Job Description / Responsibilities:

The successful candidate is expected to teach and guarantee courses focused on Anglophone literature, supervise bachelor's and master's theses, and develop pedagogical, research, and publication activities, as well as potentially contribute to the development of international activities and projects.

Qualification Requirements:

A university degree in a relevant field with a focus on English and American Studies. Ongoing or completed doctoral studies (Ph.D.), or initiation/completion of habilitation or professorial appointment procedures in the field of Anglophone literature. Language requirements: English at C1+ level.

Workload:

100% of full-time working hours

Expected Start Date:

September 1, 2026

Place of Work:

Department of English Studies, Faculty of Education, UJEP in Ústí nad Labem

Working Conditions / Career Development Opportunities:

We expect the ability to engage in creative work, publication activity, experience in academic research, and teaching practice in literature-oriented courses. present their professional background and outline their vision for working at the department. The selection will be based on the candidate's academic qualifications, professional experience, creative activity, and the presented vision.
